ABOUT SHKODER / ALBANIA

Shkodër, also known as Shkodra, is the fifth most populous city of the Republic of Albania and the capital of the eponymous municipality and county. It is one of the most ancient cities in the Balkans and exerts strong cultural, economic, and religious influences in Northern Albania. Its location has been of strategic importance throughout history, often contributing to the city's wealth or making it the subject of conflicts between foreign powers.

Geographically, Shkodër sprawls across the Plain of Mbishkodra between the freshwater marshlands of Lake Shkodër and the foothills of the Albanian Alps. Like most of the Dinaric Alps, the mountains are dominated by limestone and dolomite rocks. The lake, named after the city, is the largest in Southern Europe. The city is surrounded on three sides by the rivers Kir in the east, Drin in the south, and Buna in the west.

Phone & Roaming

WIFI is available at almost all places, hotels, restaurants and pedestrian area for free.

If somebody wants to have a **local telephone number** you need your passport to register. An albanian number in any shop (vodafone, ONE,...) costs around € 10 - € 15.

eSIM card is also an option.

Getting Around by Bike & Walk

Shkodra is famous for its bicycle tradition. It is cheap, healthy and you can get involved with the original Albanian atmosphere and street life.

There are several “rent-a-bike” services right in the neighborhood (€ 5/day).

Also every place in and around the city center can be reached in 10 minutes walking time.

If the weather do not allow the eco-friendly way a taxi inside the city will cost you around € 3 - 6 for one drive.
